



Horse Entry Requirements for the 2022 World Championship Junior Rodeo

All horses will be required to check-in, including horses staying on-site and horses being hauled in.

All horses entering the Lazy E Arena property will follow Oklahoma State Law. Currently the law requires horses entering the state of Oklahoma to have an official report of a negative EIA test (coggins) dated within 12-months, and a Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection (health papers) dated within 30-days, prior to the date of entry.

AND

All horses must be vaccinated with an FDA-approved EHV 1 and 4 & Influenza vaccine not less than 14 days prior to the event and not before January 1, 2022. If you or a vet are administering, please document the serial number that appears on the outside of the vaccine bottle or individual syringe and the date of administration on your horse check-in form.

It is recommended that ALL horses are given an EHV 1 and 4 & Influenza booster not less than 14 days and not more than 90 days prior to the date of entry.
